

Welcome to Year 7 Art

In year 7 pupils are given a foundation of skills to build on and develop throughout the rest of Key Stage 3. This is delivered through 3 units of work which students to experiment with media and materials which they may not have been exposed to at Primary School. As students come from a wide variety of different Primary School experiences, the Year 7 course supports students from a wide range of differentiated abilities through stretching the high ability whilst supporting the less confident students.

Over the 3 units in year 7, pupils should learn:

- The formal elements of Art: Line, Shape, Colour, Tone, Form, Pattern and Texture.
- Developing skills using a wide range of materials, including collage, painting, rubbings, clay, mixed media, montage.
- Developing ceramics skills, knowledge of texture and working in relief.
- Developing skills in creating a composition, through drawing, collage and painting.
- Understanding the work of other artists / designers / cultures, and how this influences the work pupils produce.
