





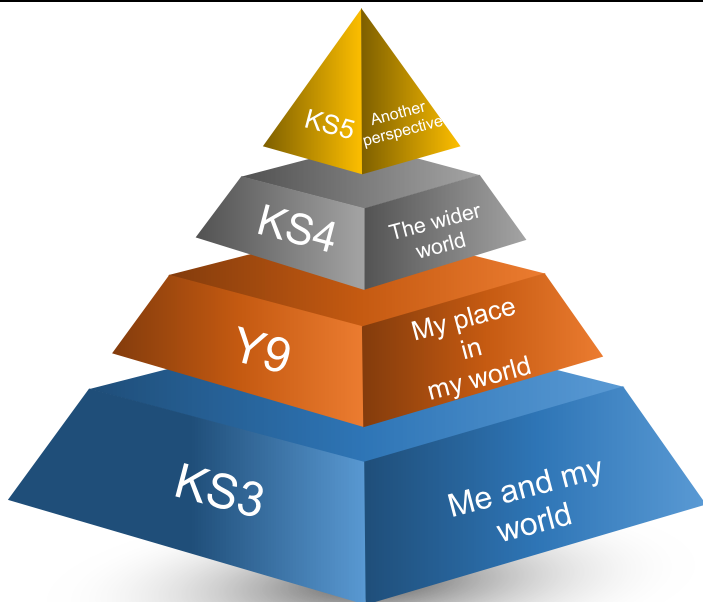


French @ WBS Year 9 Roadmap

Subject Aim: In Y9 you will make the transition from KS3 to KS4 and you will begin the GCSE programme of study. You will revisit themes and **embed language** from Y7 and Y8 while beginning to learn about **My Place in My World**. You will begin to appreciate the importance of language the world of work and will have contact with Language Ambassadors. Your **understanding** of the language will increase. Key themes this year are family and relationships and free time activities. KS3 language will be revisited and consolidated with a wider view of the Francophone world.

Autumn Term	Module 2 – Leisure   
	Revisiting the topic of leisure activities – sport, music, technology, your life online, books and reading, TV and cinema. Each them will be studied in depth with reference to the French speaking world.
Spring Term	Module 1 - Who am I?   
Summer Term	Revisiting the topic of family but with a deeper understanding and a broader perspective. Talking about relatives and describing them, relationships, arranging to go out, role models and comparing your life now to when you were younger.
