


French @ WBS Year 10 Roadmap

Subject Aim: In Y10 you will begin to explore and understand the **Wider World**, revisiting themes such as festivals, my town and holidays. You will be **stretched** and **challenged** – being exposed to a view of the **Wider World** in order to make you a more empathetic 21st century citizen who is able to **understand** other societies and ways of life. We will encourage you to become a more independent learner who can understand language patterns and can reflect on your learning.

Autumn Term	Module 3 - Ordinary days And special days   
	Revisiting KS3 themes but with much more depth and reference to the French speaking world. Learning not just about festivals, customs, traditions and special occasions but also about everyday life in France.
Spring Term	Module 4 - In town   
Summer Term	Much of this topic is new – you will revisit the Y8 topic of home but in more depth – adding descriptions of your town and region, transport, the weather and community projects.
