

French @ WBS Year 12 Roadmap

Subject Aim: The Year 12 French A level course builds on knowledge acquired at GCSE level but you will be encouraged to see the world from a broader perspective. There are 2 themes covered: **Social Issues and Trends** and **Political and artistic culture**. In the Spring term you will also start studying the **literature** component of the course in the form of a film. You will be using the OUP course and the associated Kerboodle package. **Grammar** is consolidated throughout and more advanced points are covered.
