

















Spanish @ WBS Year 8 Roadmap

Subject Aim: In Y8 we want you to become an ambitious language learner who has the desire and curiosity to discover and experience more features of Me and My World. You will build on the language basics and topics covered in Y7. Key themes will be **school, your city, holidays** and **food**. You will start to learn about language patterns and become familiar with grammatical terminology. You will learn how to express yourself in the past and future tenses as well as revisit the present tense. We will help you to embed your basic skills and develop your strengths.

	 Viva 2 Module 3 Food   
	Talking about what food you like, different meal times, ordering a meal and describing a party.
