







# Spanish @ WBS Year 9 Roadmap

**Subject Aim:** In Y9 you will make the **transition** from KS3 to KS4 and you will begin the GCSE programme of study. You will **revisit** themes and **embed language** from Y7 and Y8 while beginning to learn about **My Place in My World**. You will begin to appreciate the **importance of language** learning in the world of work and will have contact with Language Ambassadors. Your **understanding** of the language will increase. Key themes this year are holidays and schools. KS3 language will be **revisited** and **consolidated** with a wider view of the Spanish world.

Autumn Term	<b>Module 1 - Holidays</b>	  
	Revisiting the topic of holidays but with a deeper understanding and a broader perspective. Talking about weather, things to do on holidays, describing holiday preferences, reserving a hotel room and making complaints.	
Spring Term	<b>Module 2 - School</b>	  
Summer Term	Revisiting the topic of school – subjects, opinions, describing teachers, school facilities, uniform, school rules and extra-curricular activities. Each area will be studied in depth and you will be able to give your opinion about them.	

<b>Assessment</b>	<b>BT</b>
You will have 2 Key Assessments this year. Assessments will test a variety of skills and they will be different for each assessment. Your teacher will tell you which skills will be assessed.
