













# Spanish @ WBS Year 10 Roadmap

**Subject Aim:** In Y10 you will begin to explore and understand the **Wider World**, revisiting themes such as lifestyle and moving on to the topics of family relationships, leisure activities, my town and Spanish festivals and traditions. You will be **stretched** and **challenged** – being exposed to a view of the **Wider World** in order to make you a more empathetic 21<sup>st</sup> century citizen who is able to **understand** other societies and ways of life. We will encourage you to become a more **independent** learner who can understand language patterns and can **reflect** on your learning.

Autumn Term	<b>Module 3 - My people</b>	  
	Revising the KS3 topic of family but adding in relationships, partnerships and weddings. Talk about socialising, on the net or going out.	
Spring Term	<b>Module 4 - Interests and influences</b>	  
	Revisiting and the topic of leisure activities – sport, music, technology, online life, TV and cinema. Each them will be studied in depth with reference to the Spanish speaking world. Talking about role models.	
Summer Term	<b>Module 5 - Cities</b>	  
	You will revisit the Y8 topic of home but in more depth – adding descriptions of your town and area, shops, going shopping, pros and cons of city and countryside life.	
	<b>Module 6 - Traditions</b>	  
	Learning not just about Spanish festivals, customs, food, and traditions but also about everyday life in Spain.
