

Spanish @ WBS Year 12 Roadmap

Subject Aim: The Year 12 Spanish A level course builds on knowledge acquired at GCSE level but you will be encouraged to see the world from a broader perspective. There are 2 themes covered: **Social Issues and Trends** and **Political and artistic culture**. In the Spring term you will also start studying the **literature** component of the course in the form of a film. You will be using the OUP course and the associated Kerboodle package. **Grammar** is consolidated throughout and more advanced points are covered.

AUTUMN TERM		The various types of 21 st century Spanish family; trends in marriage; modern and traditional values; divorce in Spain; the religious history of Spain and the influence of the church.	There will be 6 Key assessments plus a mock exam in Year 12. Assessments will be set upon completion of each module and will test a variety of skills. The mock will be an AS Paper 1 which will assess listening, reading, translation and summarising skills.
		TOPIC 2 El ciberespacio The positive and negative influences of the internet; smartphones; the influence of social networks on Hispanic society.	HOMEWORK IN YEAR 12 Homework is used to consolidate and expand upon work done in the classroom. A variety of tasks will be set.
		TOPIC 3 La igualdad de los sexos Women in the world of work and at home; male chauvinism; feminism; LGBT rights; gay marriage in Spain and the Hispanic world.	REVISION FOR ASSESSMENTS IN YEAR 12 Reminders of assessments will be set on BrightSpace. Each assessment tests accumulated linguistic and factual knowledge.
SPRING TERM		TOPIC 4 La influencia de los ídolos The positive and negative influence musicians have on people; the effect of TV and film stars in society; young fashion models.	ENRICHMENT THEMES IN YEAR 12 The whole of the A level course provides enrichment to the students through the study of artistic, social and political themes.
		TOPIC 5 La identidad regional en España Spanish customs and traditions; gastronomy in Spain; the different languages spoken in Spain and the issues surrounding them.
