We are going to study the following modules:

YEAR 10 AQA GCSE FRENCH.

Module 3. Jours ordinaires, jours de fête.

Year 10 starts off with a module on celebrations! You will cover birthdays, festivals, traditions, party food and special occasions. By contrast you will also look at ordinary daily life. Grammar wise you will use the modal verbs *pouvoir* and *devoir*, *venir* + the infinitive and combinations of tenses.

Module 4. De la ville a la campagne.

This unit is based around local issues – your region, your town, community projects and what there is to see in the vicinity. You will revise the topic of the weather – touching on the issue of climate change. Grammatical concepts you will encounter include the pronoun *y*, negatives, using *quel* etc to ask questions and the future tense.

Module 5. Le grand large

Holidays is the theme for module 5. You will talk about your ideal holiday, hotels, restaurants, travelling and buying souvenirs. You will also look at holiday disasters! Grammar to be covered includes the conditional, *en* + past participle, *avant + de*, demonstrative adjectives and pronouns and the pluperfect tense.

Assessment - we will do end of module test that will cover some or all the 4 skills - listening, reading, writing and/or speaking.

Homework - in year 10 the department will set a minimum of 1 homework per fortnight
