








German @ WBS Year 9 Roadmap

Subject Aim: In Y9 you will make the **transition** from KS3 to KS4 and you will begin the GCSE programme of study. You will **revisit** themes and **embed** language from Y7 and Y8 while beginning to **learn** about **My Place in My World**. You will begin to appreciate the importance of language learning in the world of work and will have contact with Language Ambassadors. Your **understanding** of the language will increase. Key themes this year are education and free time activities. KS3 language will be **revisited** and **consolidated** with a wider view of the cultures of the German speaking world.
