#### **TOPIC 1 Die Wiedervereinigung und ihre** Folgen

The peaceful revolution in the GDR in 1989; German Reunification – the dream versus the reality; old and new German states; German culture and identity.

#### **ASSESSMENT IN YEAR 13**

There will be 4 Key Assessments and a mock exam in Year 13.

Assessments will be set upon completion of each module and will test a variety of skills.

#### **TOPIC 2 Einwanderung**

Causes of migration; the pros and cons of immigration and the politics of migration in the German-speaking world.

#### **HOMEWORK IN YEAR 13**

Homework is used to consolidate and expand upon work done in the classroom. A variety of tasks will be set.

#### TOPIC 3 Deutschland und die EU

The role of Germany in Europe; the pros and cons of the EU for Germany; the effects of the expansion of the EU.

#### **REVISION FOR ASSESSMENTS IN YEAR 13**

Reminders of assessments will be set on BrightSpace. Each assessment tests accumulated linguistic and factual knowledge.

#### **TOPIC 4 Integration**

Measures taken to integrate migrants; the barriers which prevent integration; the experiences of different groups of migrants in the German-speaking world.

#### **ENRICHMENT THEMES IN YEAR 13**

The whole of the A level course provides enrichment to the students through the study of artistic, social and political themes.

#### TOPiC 5 Die Politik und die Jugend

Political engagement among young people in the German-speaking world; the key points in youth politics; values and ideals.

#### **TOPIC 6 Rassismus**

The history of racism in the Germanspeaking world; the victims of racism; origins of racism; the fight against racism.
