

# Welcome to Year 8 History

Students begin year 8 by producing a detailed piece of project work on Tudor society that they create using the foundation of knowledge gained at the end of year 7. Over the course of the next term, pupils consider the seventeenth century - a highly tumultuous time in British History. After Christmas, students will learn about a very different society, focusing on the lifestyle of the Native Americans. The year concludes with a module on the Industrial Revolution and Victorian Britain.

## Assessment

Assessment in Year 8 History will take the form of six assessments testing various skills and aspects of subject knowledge over the course of the year.
