

Welcome to Year 9 History

As students move into year 9 History, they cover topics which pose more challenging questions than ever before. The year begins with a study of Slavery. Pupils consider why the practice endured for so long, before considering how it was ultimately abolished. This topic provides a context for those who wish to pursue the subject further at GCSE. After a look at protest movements more generally, including a series of lessons of the Suffragettes, students conclude the year by studying the First World War, the rise of Hitler in Germany and the causes and course of the Second World War.

Assessment

Assessment in Year 9 History will take the form of six assessments testing various skills and aspects of subject knowledge over the course of the year.
