

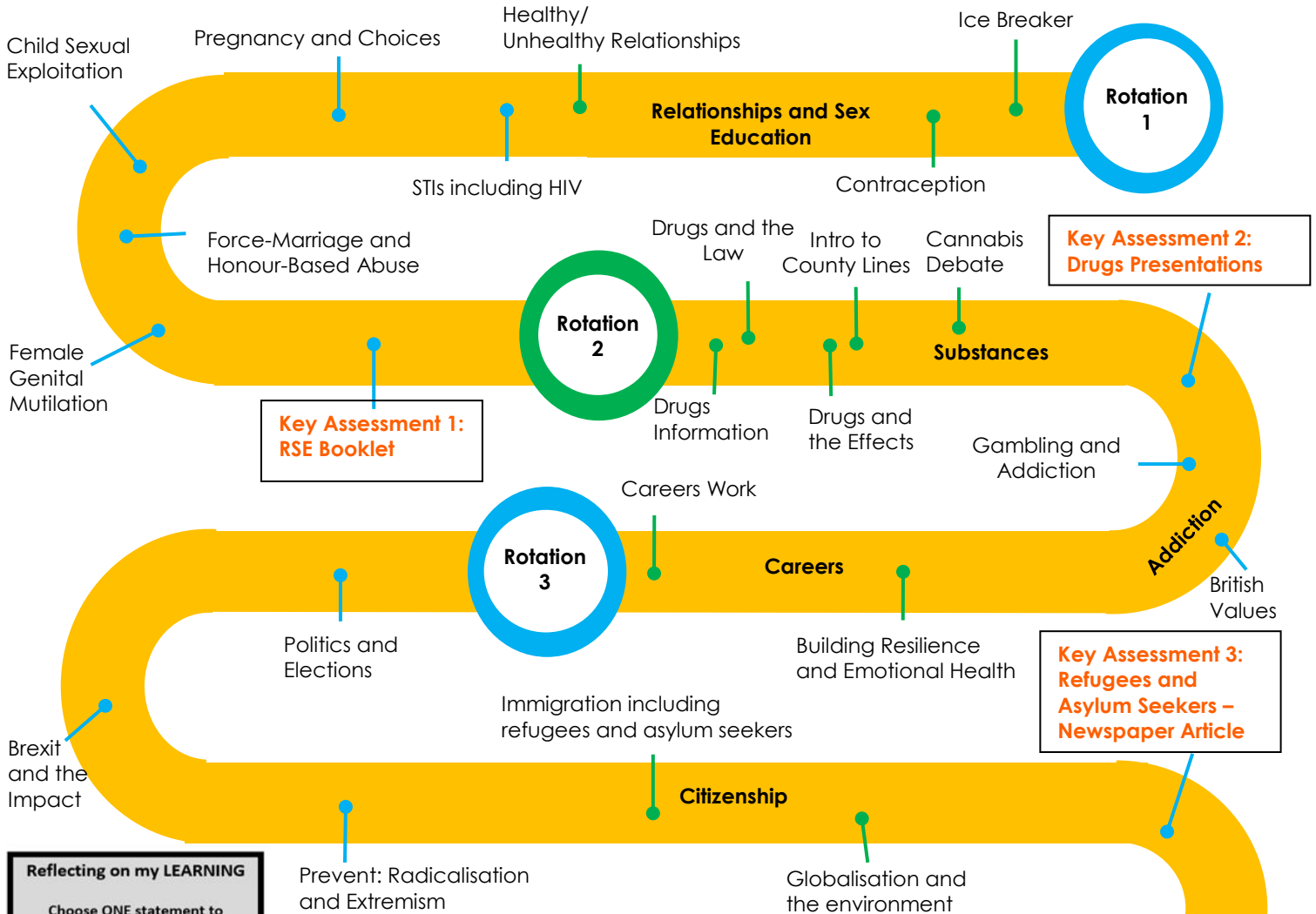
# Year 9 PSHE

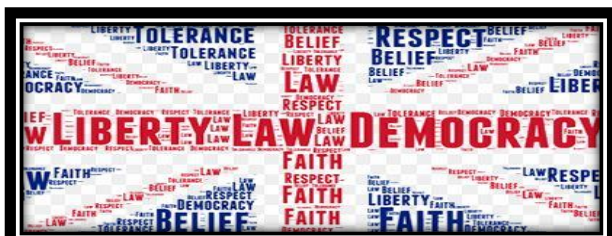
