

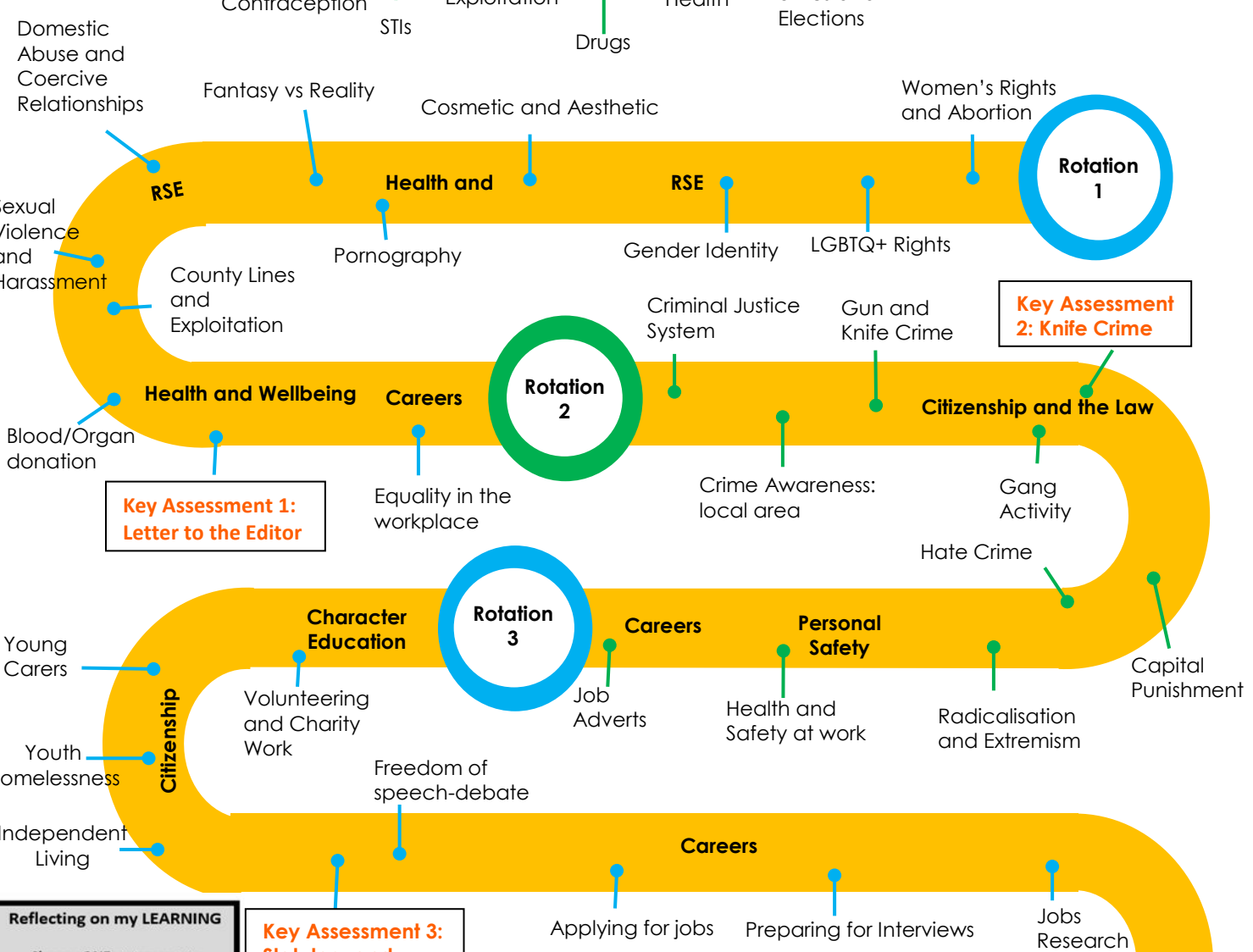
Year 10 PSHE
