The 2 themes of Social Issues and Trends and Political and Artistic Culture continue but are more multicultural and political in nature.

During the Autumn term you will study a second literary work – this time a book or a play. In addition, you will start preparing an IRP for your speaking exam.

You will be using the OUP course and the associated Kerboodle package.

Grammar is consolidated throughout and more advanced points covered.
