

Pupil Premium Funding at The West Bridgford School

A number of students at West Bridgford School benefit from Pupil Premium Funding. This is additional funding paid directly to schools to support qualifying students, including those who are eligible for Free School Meals.

This extra funding supports these children by providing additional resources and activities to enrich their time as WBS students. This may include a variety of supportive measures, which are assessed by the teams around the child on an individual basis. For example, we may be able to offer: extra tuition and academic support, subsidised trips and extracurricular activities, wellbeing support, and access to free revision materials and study resources.

Is Your Child Eligible?

Your child qualifies for Free School Meals (FSM), and therefore access to Pupil Premium (PP), if you receive:

- Universal Credit (income below £7,400 per year).
- Income-Based Jobseeker's Allowance, Income Support, or Pension Credit.
- Child Tax Credit (income below £16,190, no Working Tax Credit).
- Support under the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.

Children also qualify if they:

- Have received FSM at any point in the past 6 years.
- Are in or adopted from local authority care.
- Have had a parent in the armed forces in the past 6 years.

How to Apply

To apply for Free School Meals, and then subsequently access PP funding for your child, [visit the Nottinghamshire County Council website here](#), or call 0300 500 80 80.

Important: Registering for FSM does not mean your child must take the meals, but it ensures the school receives funding to help us to better support them.
