We are an award-winning charity working to prevent children and young people from experiencing gaming and gambling harms through awareness raising, education and research.

Through a portfolio of evidence-based programmes, we develop and deliver training and resources for a range of individuals who have influence over children and young people.

For parents and carers

We provide information, workshops and support to parents, carers and professionals who work with children in care or within an early-help setting such as social workers, family support teams and foster carers. Our City & Guilds Assured workshops are designed to provide the information and tools to help start informed safeguarding conversations. Our Parent Hub website provides additional advice and guidance.



For health professionals

We deliver specialist training to health professionals on gaming and gambling harm prevention in children and young people. Designed by psychologists and those with lived experience, this training builds understanding, skills and capabilities to address the harms; through earlier identification and referral to treatment providers. The training is City & Guilds Assured and delegates gain access to a comprehensive resource pack.

For community and faith leaders

We provide training for faith and community leaders who work with children and young people in diverse communities. This training centres on an understanding of socio-cultural and religious contexts on shame and stigma relating to gaming and gambling harms. The training equips delegates with the knowledge and understanding to identify the harms and signpost to the support that is available.



For students and universities

We deliver training to university employees who work with students such as safeguarding leads, student union staff and student welfare teams. Our City & Guilds Assured training explores the potential risks of gaming and gambling for students and empowers delegates to support and signpost students who may be experiencing harm. Our Student Hub website provides additional advice and guidance.



For teachers and youth workers

We offer City & Guilds training and resources to teachers, youth workers and professionals working in an educational setting. Targeted at professionals who work directly with children and young people, we have developed a comprehensive bank of resources that are mapped to England's PSHE curriculum and RSE Programme of Study, Curriculum for Wales, and the Curriculum for Northern Ireland with lesson plans from KS2-KS5/16+.
