

Subject Aim: In Y8 we want you to become an ambitious language learner who has the desire and curiosity to **discover and experience** more features of **Me and My World**. You will build on the language basics and topics you have covered in Y7. Key themes will be school, holidays, food, health and making arrangements. You will start to learn about language patterns and become familiar with grammatical terminology. You will learn how to express yourself in the past and future as well as revisit the present tense. You will embed your basic skills and develop your strengths.

Summer Term	Stimmt 2 Kapitel 1 Holidays		
	Discussing holidays, towns now and in the past, reviewing hotels, describing accommodation, activities on holiday and using three tenses		
	Stimmt 2 Kapitel 5 Clothes and Fashion		
	You will learn about clothing styles, typical fashions and how to make plans to revise the future tense. As well as discussing what you've done in the past tense.		

Assessment
You will have 3 Key Assessments this year. Assessments will test a variety of skills and they will be different for each assessment.
Revision will be on Arbor and in lessons.

Homework and Revision
Homework will be set on Arbor and will consist of: - Vocab learning – on Carousel - Active Learn
Reminders of assessments are published on Arbor and each assessment will revisit all the previous content of the course. This means you need to revise the recent topics but also revisit the old ones.
