



## **Year 7 Catch-Up Premium**

### **What is the Catch-Up Premium?**

Catch-up Premium provides additional funding to schools for each year 7 pupil who did not achieve the national standard in Key Stage 2 national curriculum tests in reading and/or mathematics. The purpose of this funding is to allow schools to deliver additional support, such as small group interventions, for these pupils.

For the Academic Year 2018-19 the West Bridgford School received a total of £8,759.

### **How do we use the Catch-Up Premium?**

Additional Teachers and specialist Teaching Assistants have been appointed to English and Maths which allows for small group work and/or 'one to one' tuition. These sessions are tailored to meet student's individual needs and accelerate their progress. (£5000)

Specialised small group tailored intervention occurs in replace of a modern foreign language for pupils in Year 7, the pupils access the Read, Write Fresh Start programme. (£2,500)

Access to Lexia programme, an online personalised programme which enables readers to master essential reading skills. (£1259)
